	Additional information for those eligible for Employment Insurance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Canadians who are already receiving EI regular and sickness benefits as of today would continue to receive their benefits and should not apply to the CERB If their EI benefits end before October 3, 2020, they could apply for the CERB once their EI benefits cease, if they are unable to return to work due to COVID-19 Canadians who have already applied for EI and whose application has not yet been processed would not need to reapply Canadians who are eligible for EI regular and sickness benefits would still be able to access their normal EI benefits, if still unemployed, after the 16-week period covered by the CERB 	Click here for more information
